Full Membership | \$75

Open to accounting, financial or administrative officials whose duties encompass significant responsibilities for accounting or financial systems or individuals involved in key decision making on the financial affairs of their public organization. Full membership supports public professionals from all units of government in Kansas: state, county, city, school, college, university and special districts. Individuals holding teaching positions in government finance or accounting at an accredited college or university may also become full members.

Retiree Membership | \$25

Open to those who have retired from public finance roles but want to stay engaged with the association.

Associate Membership | \$300

For individuals or firms who are not eligible to be a full member, but who are interested in the principals and practices of governmental finance. Includes membership for three named individuals per association.

Student Membership | \$5

For students enrolled full time at an accredited academic institution and pursuing a course of study in governmental finance or accounting.
